

EXHIBITORS Term and Conditions

Definition, Terms and Conditions

Exhibitor means any person from or company who has been granted a space at the said Exhibition/ Wedding Fayre, as per Application Form. Hence the Organisers being C.J.Wedding Fayres and Events, or its lawful assigns. This shall be in accordance with English Law, as said in the relevant contracts.

Duration of the Exhibition

Details of Fayres or Exhibitions hours will be in writing in the signed contract. Stands must be manned at all times by exhibitor's staff during these times

Applications for stand space

This is on the understanding of our terms and conditions, as said in the signed contract. Dangerous, explosive, harmful or inflammable items, are not allowed and will be removed by the Organiser with immediate effect. Exhibitors must keep to their designated space, hence containing stands, and equipment, stand up banners etc within their given space. You must not block walkways/ Fire Exits or infringe on other exhibitors space.

Payment

A £50 Deposit at time of booking and the Balance due one month prior to the event

Cancellation

Cancellation 4 weeks or prior to the event – 50% of full payment
Cancellation within the 4 weeks prior to event- Full Payment Due
No monies refunded due to inclement weather conditions

Attendance or Footfall

The Organisers shall not be responsible for the failure of any number of attendees/exhibitors to attend the Exhibition for any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Organisers

Letting of a stand

Once booked the exhibitor is not allowed to sublet, whole or any part of the space booked. If an exhibitor goes bankrupt, goes into administration, receivership or liquidation the organiser has the right to terminate the contract without refunding any monies.

Indemnity

The Exhibitor shall indemnify the organisers against all costs claim demands proceedings and losses made against or incurred by the organisers as a result of the exhibitor exhibiting or advertising any goods or services in the exhibition

Postponement or Abandonment of the Venue

The Exhibitor cannot claim against the Organiser, for the venue being unavailable for any said reason. Hence, the organiser must be allowed to make the necessary changes eg. Change of venue, date, or period of exhibition stand size, location or otherwise.

Exhibitors Insurance

The Organisers are not responsible for the safety of any exhibit or their property or other person, or for loss, damage or injury sustained by the Exhibitor or other person. This is whether by reason of any defaulting the exhibition caused by fire, tempest, lightning, explosion, national emergency, war, labour disputes, epidemic e.g. foot and mouth disease etc, strikes, lock-outs, civil disturbances, inevitable accident, force majeure or any other cause not within the direct control of the organisers whether of the same kind or not. No responsibility can be accepted for any consequences of prevention, postponement or abandonment of the exhibition, Exhibitors should secure their own insurance to cover all liabilities and risks.

Fire Precautions

All materials used for building, decoration and covering stands must be non-flammable material. Exhibitors must comply with all instructions given by relevant authorities to avoid the risk of fire or any other risk.

With regard to any vehicles forming part of any exhibition, the battery must be disconnected and the fuel fillers sealed. A designated fire extinguisher must be kept close by. The Organisers reserve the right to exclude any vehicle that in the opinion of the organisers is not considered fit to exhibit.

Exclusion of Personnel

The Organisers reserve the right in their absolute discretion to exclude or remove from the Exhibition, any person whose presence is or likely to be undesirable.

Admission

The Organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to any company that does not display product, services or equipment which are in keeping with the event, or who have not paid in full for their stand/or related services, or at their sole discretion may be of harm to their commercial interests.

Noise

No public address system, music, generators or electric amplification shall be operated from any trade stand or exhibition without prior consent in writing from the Organisers. No noise likely to cause distress to the public or traders will be permitted

Dismantling of Exhibits

No exhibit shall be packed, removed or dismantled prior to the closing of the Exhibition without prior written consent from the Organiser. If the Exhibitor acts in breach of this provision he shall pay, compensation for the detraction to the Exhibitors appearance and in addition of all sums otherwise due under this agreement, an amount equal to one third of the total display charge for the Exhibitors allocated area. The Exhibitor must remove all exhibits and display materials from the allocated area before the notified time of closure of the Exhibition; otherwise, a handing and storage charge will apply. The Exhibitor must leave the said stand space in its original condition, and shall make good and indemnify the Organiser for any damage to the premises by the Exhibitor, his agents, contractors or employees.

Health and Safety

Exhibitors must act in accordance to relevant legislation on Health and Safety and Risk Management appropriately
